NOTICE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS

Subject: Invitation to Bid on Purchase Order Contracts

Description: Provide materials, skilled labor, equipment and traffic control for the following:

- Installation of Thermoplastic and Paint Pavement Markings
- Installation of Polyurea, Cold Applied Plastic and Paint Pavement Markings
- Installation of Snowplowable and Raised Reflective Markers

These are separate bid proposals and will be utilized on various routes in Division 4 on an as-needed basis upon the request of the Engineer.

The terms of these contracts shall be effective upon notification by the Department that the purchase orders have been approved. The contracts will remain in effect until June 30, 2010.

Sealed Bids must be received in the Division Office at 509 Ward Blvd., Wilson, NC 27893 by **2:00 PM** on **Tuesday December 1, 2009**. Bids must be submitted on the official bid sheet included in the proposal and display the appropriate statement on the front of the envelope (as described in each proposal).
