**GENERAL NOTES**

- 1- USE THIS DETAIL FOR OPERATIONS SUCH AS ERECTION AND REMOVAL OF OVERHEAD SIGNS, BRIDGE GIRDERS, OR OTHER TYPES OF CONSTRUCTION WHERE THE ENTIRE TRAVELWAY MUST BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC.
- 2- IMPLEMENT THIS TYPE OF ROAD CLOSURE DURING PERIODS OF LOW TRAFFIC VOLUMES. DEplete THE EXISTING TRAFFIC QUEUE BEFORE RECLOSING THE ROADWAY TO TRAFFIC IF MULTIPLE CLOSURES ARE REQUIRED.
- 3- TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES ARE SHOWN FOR ONE DIRECTION OF TRAFFIC APPROACHING THE ROAD CLOSURE, THE SAME DEVICES APPLY FOR THE OPPOSITE TRAFFIC DIRECTION.
