**REASON FOR CHANGE:**

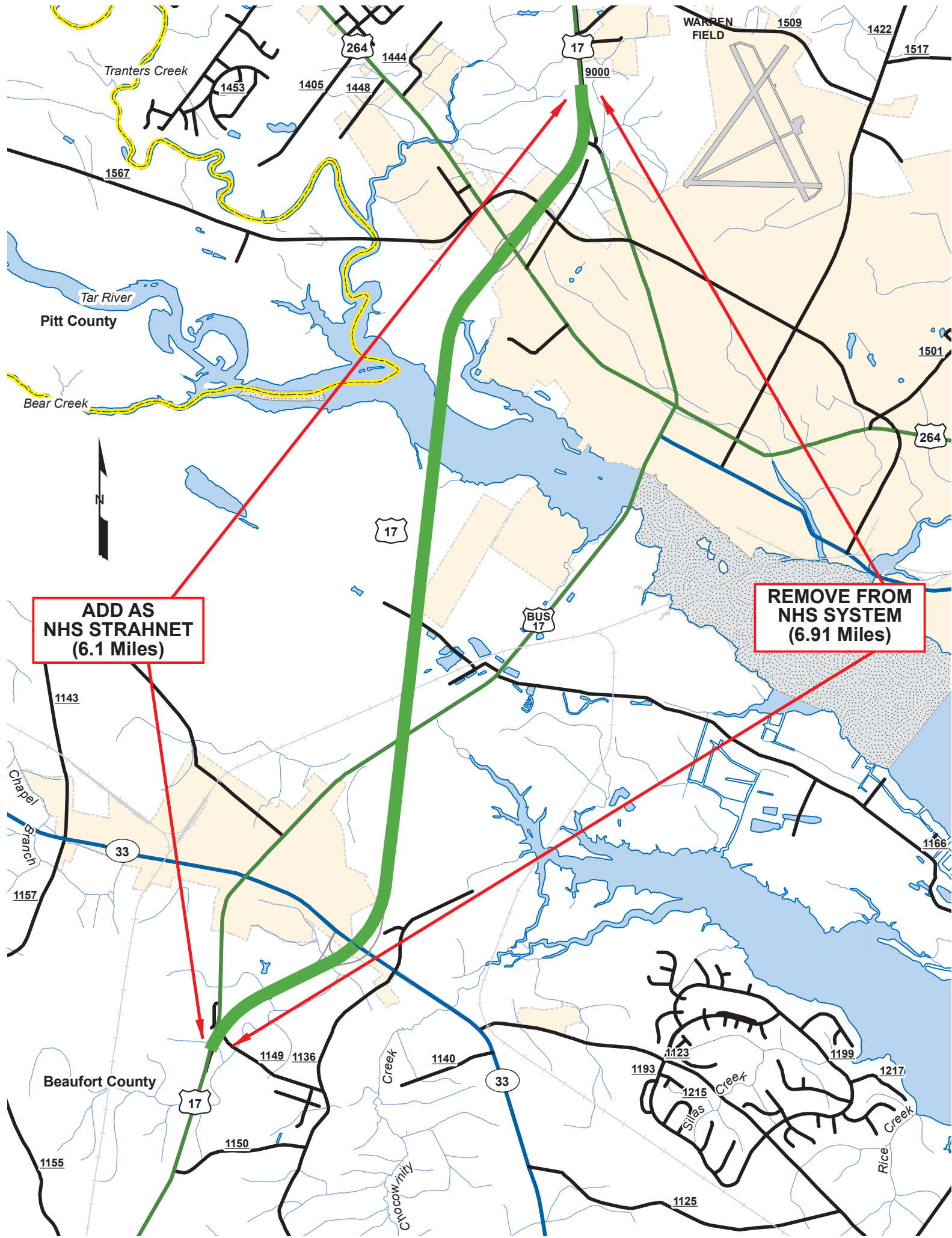
To relocate the National Highway System (NHS) along the newly constructed four lanes divided US 17 Bypass west of the City of Washington. The Functional Classification System has been revised to support the NHS revision. The Mid East RPO and the City of Washington approve the NHS change.

**PROPOSED ADDITION:**

R-2510B, US 17 Business southern termini to the US 17 Business northern termini, adds as NHS STRAHNET Corridor. (6.1 Miles)

US 17 Business, US 17 southern termini to the US 17 northern termini, remove as NHS STRAHNET Corridor. (6.91 Miles)
